At MPS, we believe that student appearance is a reflection of school pride and personal discipline. To that end, our uniform policy will be strictly enforced.

It is the responsibility of all parents, guardians, and students to ensure full adherence to the uniform standards outlined below.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

No visible clothing under uniform shirts or skirts- No leggings, jeggings, or tights without feet- No jogging pants- No long-sleeve shirts under short-sleeve tops- Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than three inches above the knee- No tight-fitting clothing or jeggings allowed.

GIRLS Uniform

Dress Uniform (Monday, Wednesday & Special Events or Field Trips)

Pre-K to 6th

- Plaid jumper, skirt, skort, or shorts (jumper must include logo)- Yellow Peter Pan collar blouse or Yellow Oxford blouse with logo- Plaid or navy-blue cross tie- Navy or black Mary Janes- Black or navy knee-high socks (Required Daily)

Grades 7th to 12th

- Plaid skirt with Blue Oxford blouse with logo-Plaid or navy-blue cross tie.
- Light blue polo shirt with logo (ONLY with plaid bottoms)
- Black/white saddle shoes, brown Sperry's, or Penny Loafers
- Black or navy knee-high socks (Required Daily)

Free Dress Days:	Free dress days will be announced; School spirit shirt or sweatshirt must be worn with any bottoms of choice.			

BOYS - GRADES K to 12

Dress Uniform (Monday, Wednesday, Field Trips & Special Events)

Grades K to 6th

- Khaki pants (no cargo, double pockets, or cell pockets)- Gold polo shirt with logo- Light blue Oxford shirt with logo + plaid tie (at least one required)

Grades 7th to 12th

- Khaki pants (standard cut)- Light blue polo shirt with logo- Light blue Oxford shirt with logo
- + plaid or approved tie (at least one required)

APPROVED OUTERWEAR

Students must have one of the following:

- Solid navy blazer with logo (Dress Uniform)
- Solid navy V-neck sweater (long sleeve)- Solid navy sleeveless vest
- Solid navy button-up cardigan- Optional: Plaid monogram on sweater/cardigan

Outerwear Guidelines

 No hooded jackets or sweatshirts allowed-No external branding (sports teams, other schools, fraternities/sororities)

Shoes (All Grades)

- Solid black or dark brown leather shoes with rubber soles- No tennis shoes, even in black or brown- Black, navy, or dark argyle socks (must be visible above ankle)

SOCKS & TIGHTS

Girls: - Navy/white knee-high socks (daily)-Navy, black, or white tights with feet may be worn under skirts/jumpers only- Shorts/skorts must be worn with full-length knee socks

Boys: - Navy or black socks (must rise above ankle)

BELT POLICY- Solid black or dark brown leather belt required- No branding, logos, names, or oversized buckles.

FORMAL UNIFORM REQUIREMENT

Mondays, Wednesdays & Special Events

- Boys: Navy-blue blazer with logo- Girls (7-12): Navy-blue blazer with logo

FREE DRESS & SPECIAL APPROVAL

DAYS- Tennis shoes & casual wear allowed ONLY on approved free dress days- Students must follow modesty & safety standards
